MLA LeRoy Johnson Mission to Washington, D.C.  
September 25-28, 2007

## Overview:

LeRoy Johnson, MLA Wetaskiwin-Camrose, represented the Government of Alberta at meetings of the World Bank and the Inter-American Development Bank in Washington, D.C. on September 26 and 27, 2007.

Johnson is a member of the Alberta government's International Development and Governance Advisory Committee which advises government on opportunities for Alberta to share its governance expertise with other jurisdictions.

The mission was successful in meeting its objectives as outlined below.

## Mission Objectives:

- participate, on behalf of the Government of Alberta, in meetings of the World Bank and Inter-American Development Bank

## Results:

The Government of Alberta's participation supported Alberta companies seeking business opportunities through infrastructure, energy and governance projects funded by the World Bank and the Inter-American Development Bank in developing countries.

Johnson, along with two Alberta companies, Matrix Solutions and the Northern Alberta Institute of Technology (NAIT), participated in the meetings as part of the Canadian delegation. Other members of the delegation included companies from Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec and Nova Scotia.

Johnson met with representatives from Matrix Solutions and NAIT to learn about their infrastructure, energy and governance project interests and expertise. In turn, meetings with the World Bank and Inter-American Development Bank shed light on projects the financial institutions are developing and possible opportunities for Alberta companies and the Alberta Government.
