Overview:

Len Mitzel, MLA for Cypress-Medicine Hat traveled to San Angelo, Texas, to represent Alberta at the Ports-to-Plains Trade Corridor Alliance (PTP) quarterly Board of Directors meeting to conduct the business affairs of the organization, address common issues and collaborate in areas of mutual interest.

The mission was successful in meeting its objectives as outlined below.

Mission Objectives:

1. Work with the PTP to integrate Alberta into the day-to-day affairs of the organization and to establish an Alberta voice within the organization.
